Targets: *Strategy*

- **NOVA-BOVA reflected in the university strategy and action plan**
- **Including into action plan of local student's council**
- **Selection of priority areas for activities (MSc JS programmes, courses, interest in selected areas for networking in projects)**
- **Strategic areas for cooperating with NOVA-BOVA**

TARGETS: *Funding*

- ***Internal funding (university internal budget), including student forum at local university***
- ***Need to establish budget for projects with BOVA targets- efforts to be made for current budget of 2005***
- ***Interests of BOVA reflected in university's fund raising from outside sources strategy***

Organisation and Human resources

- **Organisational structure within institution to be revised**
- **Local steering group to be established, including:**
 1. *local BOVA cc member-leader;*
 2. *coordinator-deputy,*
 3. *local BSF coordinator,*
 4. *contact persons from each of 5 faculties,*
 5. *heads of study unit, research unit, investment project unit*

Motivating people

- *Admission to PhD system could be motivating those who participated in NOVA-BOVA courses*
- *MSc credit transfer system should be motivating students*
- *Incorporating load of teachers into regular teaching load with motivating index (3 to 5)*
- *Evaluation system for teachers should motivate those teaching in JS programmes and courses*
- *Modest support should motivate students to get involved in BSF activities*

INFORMATION FLOW

- **Need to strengthen public relations and promotion. Simply measures:**
 - 1. *Shortcuts to BOVA and NOVA websites on university front Web page***
 - 2. *Sharing of shortcuts with partner universities***
 - 3. *Dissemination and exchange via local faculty contact persons***
 - 4. *Diversification of communication instruments (electronic conference)***
 - 5. *Dissemination of outside university***
 - 6. *Focus on: informing, reminding, persuading***
